membership which is granted to those whose membership is conducive to further support and development of the Council activities, be it financial or moral.

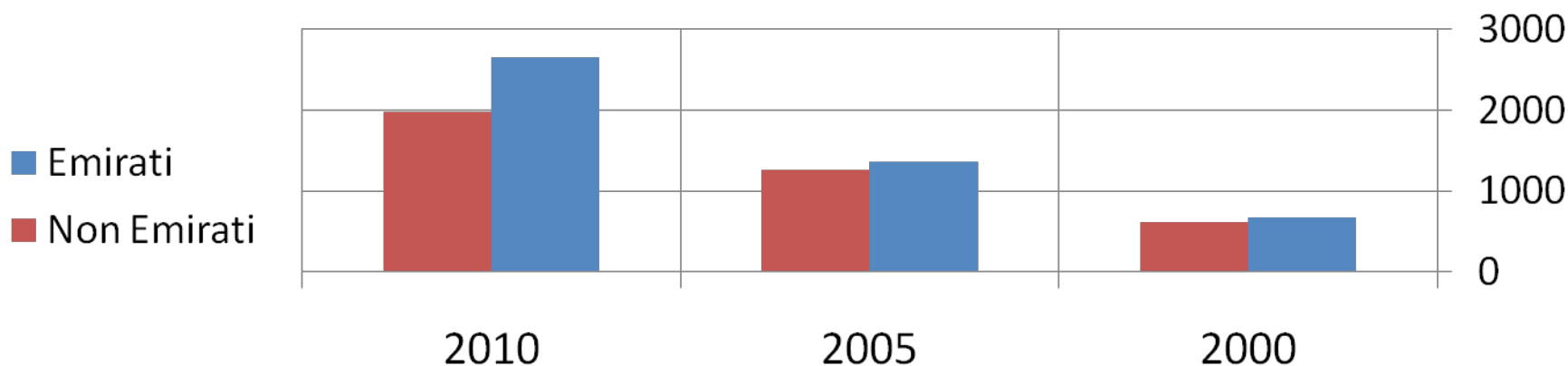
Founder Membership
